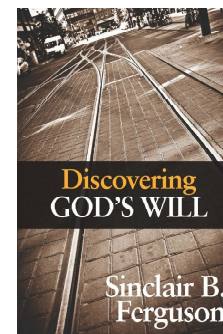
June 5 – Summer Mid-Week service schedule begins (6:30–7:30).
